

The CHP is looking into the accident on a Union Pacific track near Second and Clay streets, causing the death of a man struck and killed by a train in Woodland yesterday morning. . The victim may have been walking along the track when he was hit. Call Woodland cops if you know anything. Thirty-five-year-old Jose Pelayo-Ortega (puh-LYE-oh or-TAY-guh) of Diamond Springs in el dorado county will be charged with interfering with the flight's crew and attendants on a Sacramento-bound flight. Pelayo-Ortega tried to open a door during the United Air Lines flight from Chicago to Sacramento and claimed to have a bomb before he was subdued by other passengers and federal agents, The flight then made an unscheduled stop in Denver, where Pelayo-Ortega was taken into custody and the plane was checked for explosives before being allowed to continue to Sacramento. both Lieutenant Governor Cruz Bustamante and Los Angeles Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa have received death threats. governor said other elected officials of Mexican heritage have also received disturbing and hateful death threats. the FBI is investigating a potentially racially motivated violent crime against a Latino-owned restaurant in San Diego. the building was burned and defaced with an anti-Mexican statements painted on the wall. whatever is necessary to bring these threatening dumbies to justice should be implemented a s a p. the laws protecting our officials and business owners are already on the books. if it sounds like existng laws lack enforcement, try the laws controlling our borders. A public defender will represent the man accused of killing a Stockton mother of three. Thirty-four-year-old Reynaldo Dungo was appointed a public defender during his arraignment yesterday. he's been arrested for the murder of 30-year-old Lucinda Correia Pina, and has ben on suicide watch but it hasn't happened yet. Twenty-one-year-old Alfredo Vargas is in custody for raping and robbing Lodi residents. he's to have burglarized a Lodi apartment, raped one female resident and threatened to kill at least two other people. a Lodi Police dog sniffed out and bit Vargas this past weeknd in a Galt backyard after he tried dumping a stolen car nearby. a state Assembly committee approved a bill yesterday that would place a windfall profit tax on oil companies. the companies posted the highest corporate profits in history, and that has outraged consumers and many lawmakers. the proposed two-percent tax would kick in when an oil company's income exceeded ten-million-dollars. the Governor wants the California Energy Commission to investigate gasoline price increases, and has requested any evidence of market manipulation, price gouging and unfair business practices. he hasn't made any coment onthe windfall tax proposal. A new survey shows blacks are more likely to distrust the health care system. more blacks are forced to use emergency rooms or clinics, and don't develop a relationship with doctors and nurses, and the reason is a lack of health insurance.

former burger king Chief Executive Gregory Brenneman gets a generous severance package at the same time burger king reported a net loss for its fiscal third quarter. Brenneman will be paid a salary and annual bonus payment of two-point-zero-six-million-dollars for fiscal 2006 and will receive continued payment of his base salary at the time of separation of one-point-zero-three-million-dollars "for three years from the end of the consulting period." get fired, get a bonus. own burger king stock? what do you think. Did you know suspects convicted of felony child pornography don't have to register on the Megan's Law web site, and Republican Senator Jim Battin's bill would close that loophole, ensuring anyone convicted on child pornography charges would have to have their information listed on the site.
